

Here is a summary of Community activities at Greys Church:
May 2026

Pastoral visits : members of the church community try to visit fellow parishioners that are known to be ill , lonely or otherwise distressed.

Bible study group : The Zoom Bible Study Group continues to meet on Wednesday afternoons. The Group also meet in person regularly on Mondays in the Elizabeth Room.

Andrea's Cafe is held monthly throughout the year and continues to be much appreciated and is an excellent community gathering.

The Village Fete took place at Greys Court in September.

A Christmas Greeting Card and Patronal Appeal (to fund repairs to the bell tower) were distributed to every home in the parish.

Weekly emails are sent from the benefice office each week.

House Communion is available within the Benefice for those unable to attend church.

Two services a month are held in the church: Choral evensong on the second Sunday and Holy Communion on the fourth Sunday.

“ Families at Four “ was introduced in 2025 and is held on Sunday afternoons, once a month in the Elizabeth Room and brings together local families for snacks and play.

Food Bank: Collections for the Food Bank are made as part of the Churches Together movement.

Giving Tree: Presents are placed under the tree and then delivered to be distributed by NOMAD in Henley to families in time for Christmas.

Major Projects for 2026 are repairs to the bell tower and the south wall of the nave along with the refurbishment of the vestry.
